



Posters of women

Pedagogical concept: Students learn about Holocaust history through individual women's stories, and **apply their knowledge** through creating their own **poster**. By making informative posters, students learn how to sort out important information and remember it through active learning. Students "**educate themselves**" by becoming creators of their own learning material.

Duration: 45 min

Necessary materials: 1-page or 5-pages biographies printed: <u>https://www.her-stories.eu/en/stories</u>

Level: All

Description of the activity/methods:

Create small groups of 3-4 students. Give a woman's biography to each group and ask them to read it and create a poster about her or her story.

You can give them guiding questions:

- What are the main life events that you would like to add to the poster?
- What is your perception about her as a person? What is she like? What are her main characteristics?
- Would you like to add other people to the poster? Who are the most important people in her life?
- What are her most important or interesting thoughts for you that you would add to her poster?

At the end of the workshop ask each group to present their poster.
